Gill Kirk is running a series of **two day** workshops for beginners based on an exploration of some of the Upper Nidderdale's hay meadows.

Day one, weather permitting, the group will explore the meadows- learning about the flora and fauna, taking photographs, using microscopes, gathering information and perhaps sketching. Day two will be a creative response to the images collected and the experience in the field.

Saturday 27th June: from 10.00am - 4.00pm 'Out and About' in the hay meadows.
Meeting at number 6 studio gallery and on to researching on site.

Sunday 28th June 10.00am-4.00pm. Accessible screen printing at number 6.
Using silk screen printing frames we will make stencils and use plant material to create images reflecting meadow flora. You will learn some basic screen printing techniques and leave with some lovely prints to treasure.

Wednesday 29th July 10.00am- 4.00pm. 'Out and About' in the hay meadows.
Meeting at number 6 studio gallery and on to researching on site

Thursday 30th July 10.00am-4.00pm. Making your own mono prints at number 6
Using a variety of techniques we will learn how to produce single prints that are completely unique. You will have some lovely images to treasure and the knowledge to develop your skills after the workshop.
