### **Key stage 1 – years 1 & 2**

Learning With Birds meets the National Curriculum requirements for Science by allowing pupils to:-

- Learn about different species of birds
- Explore and answer questions about animals in their habitat
- Explore the basic needs of animals to allow their survival
- Learn about seasonal change in the world around them
- Learn how to observe and develop ways of working scientifically

### **Key stage 2**

Learning With Birds meets the National Curriculum requirements for Science by allowing pupils to:-

- Learn about different species of birds
- Explore and answer questions about animals in their habitat
- Explore the needs of birds in relation to food and shelter in particular
- Learn about breeding cycles and food chains
- Learn about the potential for man's positive impact upon the natural world
- Learn about seasonal change and the impact upon the natural world
- Learn how to observe and to record data which can be used to evaluate activities
- Use the data to identify and to represent findings as averages or trends
- Develop ways of working scientifically
